SISTER BRENDA GAIL FACYSON**

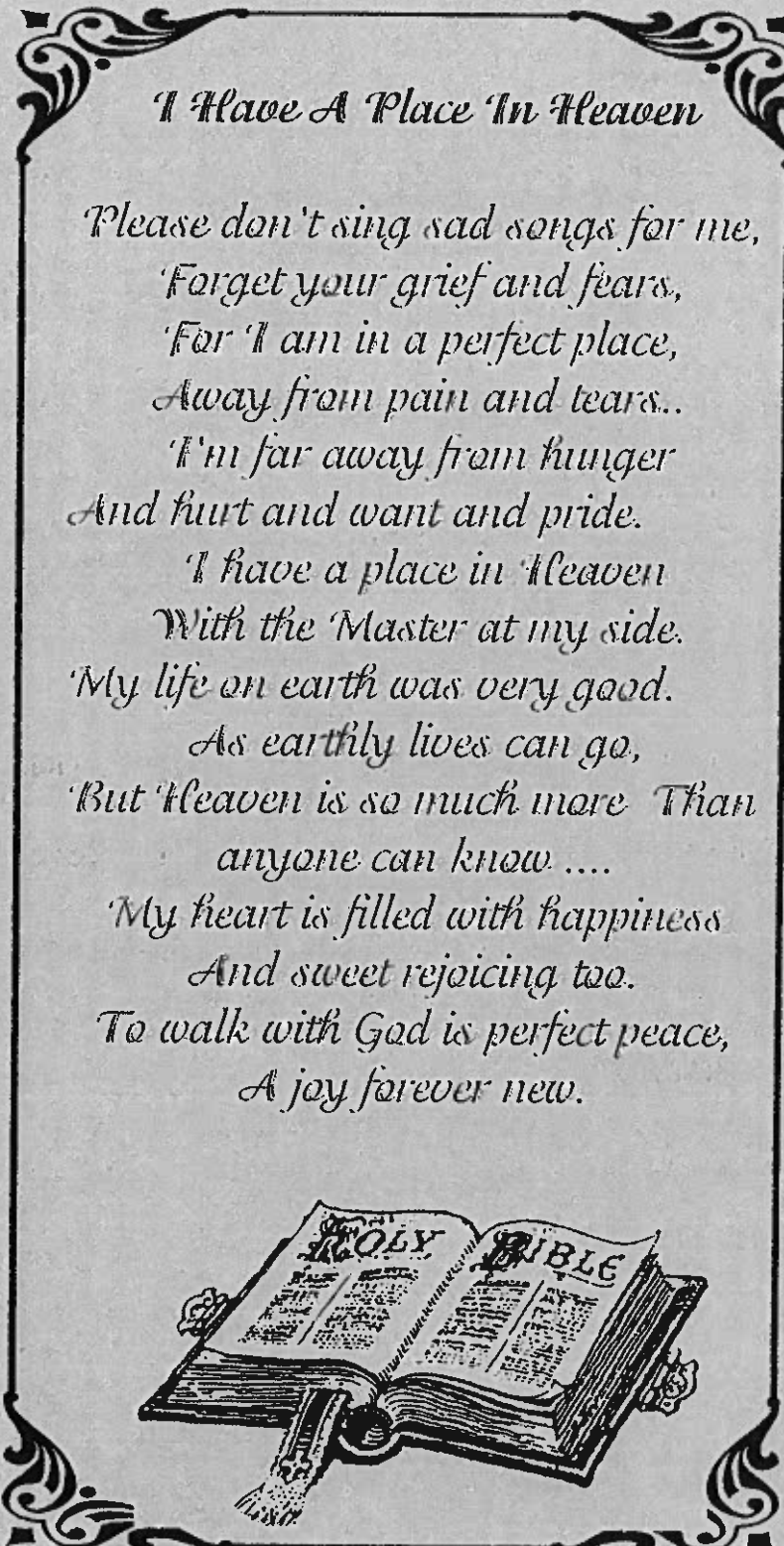
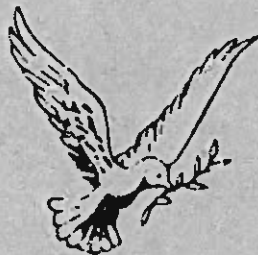
Brenda was born January 17, 1950 in a quaint little town, Jenkin County, Millen, Georgia. to the late Deacon Thomas & Ida Facyson.

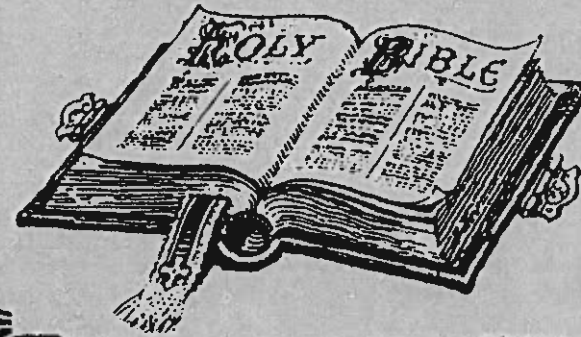
Survivors include...
