OBITUARY

John C. Greene was born on October 3, 1909. He was the eldest child of six children of John and Dora Greene of Fort Mitchell, Alabama.

He attended Bulloch County Schools in Georgia, Tuskegee Institute in Alabama and Wayne State University in Michigan.

Mr. Greene was baptized at an early age at Scarborough Baptist Church in Georgia. Upon moving to Michigan, he joined Plymouth United Church of Christ.

On April 6, 1947, John was joined in holy matrimony to Vida L. Shank. To this union was born two daughters, Gail L. and Evelyn Irene.

He was a teacher of mathematics at Southeastern High School in Detroit, Michigan. He had served as principal of Greensboro High School in Greensboro, Georgia and had been on the faculty at Alcorn College, Alcorn, Mississippi. Prior to joining the Detroit Public School System, he was employed as an electrician at Ford Motor Company and Michigan Consolidated Gas Company. He was affiliated with various civic and community organizations.

Mr. Greene passed on Monday, February 3, 1975.

He is survived by his wife, Vida L. and two daughters, Gail L. and Evelyn Irene. Other family members include: three sisters: Mrs. Evelyn Burks of Detroit, Mrs. Carolyn Lewis of Statesboro, Ga. and Mrs. Alberta Ball of Claxton, Ga.; two brothers, James Greene of Statesboro, Ga. and George Greene of Sicklerville, N.J. and a host of other relatives and friends.
