On March 12, 1998, the sun set for him at Bullock Memorial Hospital.

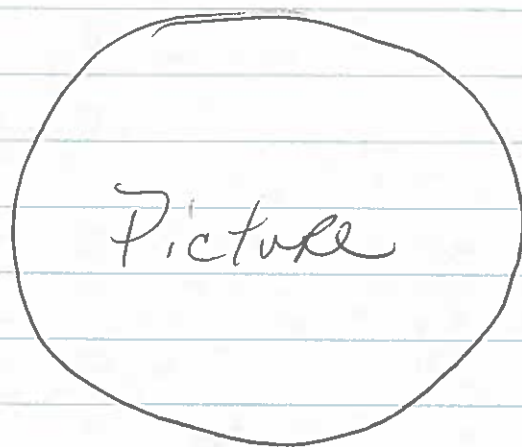
