# Obituary

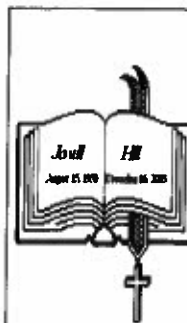


Mrs. Jewell Hill was born on August 15, 1950 in Chatham County to the late Mr. Buddy Long and the late Mrs. Mary Long.
