



Time For Polio Shots

An apparent trend in the television industry is toward the "pat-on-the-back" biurb—in the form of an hour or hour-and-a-half "spectacutar."

The latest was the Bob Hope hour-and-a-half splurge on Life Magazine's 25th anniversary. The show was sorry all the way, and even one of Sid Caesar's performances (not up to par) couldn't get the show moving.

The reason is simple: these so-called entertainment spectaculars are nothing more than an effort by a company, or a top executive or two, to do a little bragging and get into the limelight. And hundreds of thousands of dollars are spent for this purpose.

Now that March is here and Spring is just around the corner, it is time to think of polio.

Summer is only about three months away. And last year it was shocking to observe the number of polio cases which struck down victims, some of whom had not taken preventive serum.

Polio shots now come in a series, and there is a promise of a one-shot vaccine also. But if you have taken the shots in past years, that does not necessarily mean you need not bother this year.

Booster shots are often necessary and you should check with your doctor, who will look at your personal record, and tell you what, if any, additional vaccination you need.

Crippling polio is almost always prevented if the vaccine has been used. Some contract the less destructive form of the disease after being immunized but auch cases are relatively few in number.

There are now two accepted vaccines and every adult should see to it that dependent children receive vaccine protection. Adults, too, should have protection, and up to the age of forty protection is certainly a "must." We should be thankful for the development of a polio vaccine—a great step in the progress of medicine—and this is the time of year to take advantage of it.




