Bisher To Head Ga. Xmas Seals

Forman Bisher, sports editor of the Atlanta Journal, has been named chairman of Georgia's 1961 Christmas Seal Campaign, it was announced today by Roy Wilkins, Macon, president of the Georgia Tuberculosis Association.

An outstanding sports writer and analyst, Mr. Bisher will be working with the national chairman, Charles O. Finley, owner of the Kansas City Athletics, and other sports figures throughout the country to alert every citizen of the urgency to conquer a disease that takes an American life every 50 minutes.

Long interested in the disease which strikes athletes and weaklings alike, Mr. Bisher accepted the appointment by saying, "The Christmas Seal has been symbolic of the fight against tuberculosis in the life of the Christ, and being a carpenter and a lover of good wishes at such a happy season."

A native of North Carolina, Mr. Bisher has been sports editor of the Atlanta Journal since 1957. Following graduation from the University of North Carolina, he served on the staff of two North Carolina weeklies, the Highpoint Interprise and the Charlotte News. Prior to his appointment on the Journal, he was sports editor of the Atlanta Constitution for seven years.

A regular contributor to national magazines, the Bisher byline has appeared in Saturday Evening Post, Sport, True, and Sports Illustrated. He is a four-time winner of the Georgia State Associated Press Sports Writing Award and in 1955 was further honored by the editors of "The Best Sports Story of the Year" for a column written at the Master's Club in Savannah in August.

"The Christmas Seal theme this year," Mr. Bisher said, "is to protect the family circle. When the Christmas Seals are mailed throughout the nation on November 15, I urge every Georgian to buy and use them as a reminder that the fight against tuberculosis is never over and that conquest of the disease will benefit all mankind our neighbors, our families and even ourselves."

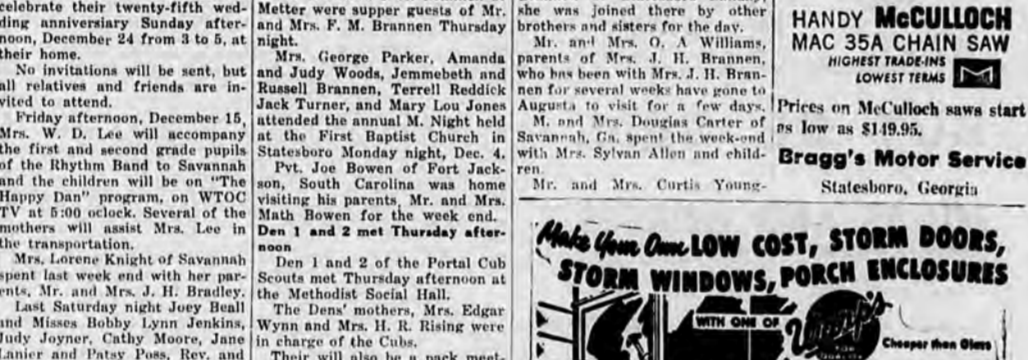
