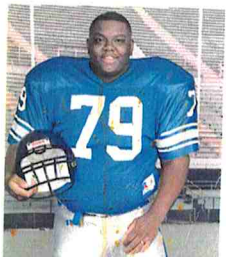
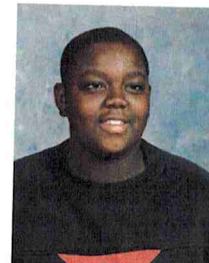
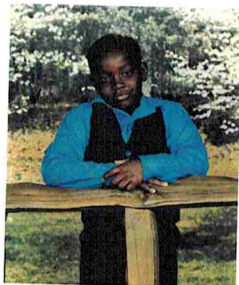
~ Obituary ~
