Not only was the resolution silly, as some of the more forthright members of the House said in debate, it was based on a false premise. The court is not gulity of high crimes and misdemeanors, as the measure said. Even those whose hatred of the court is great because of its decision relative to school segregation know this to be

Many members of the General Assembly shared our opinion that it was a typical act of reckless demagoguery which tends to nullify the constructive things the state seeks to do and subjects us to ridicule and makes us vulnerable to the charges of our critics.
