OBITUARY

Again death has invaded the ranks of Mount Arrett Primitive Baptist Church and carried away a faithful member. Deacon Cleve McBride was born June 4, 1898 in Faceville, Georgia. He was the son of the late Mr. Dennis and Mrs. Caroline McBride.

Early in life he moved to Grady County, Georgia. There he was converted at an early age and joined Rinie Grove Primitive Baptist Church of Whigham, Georgia.

He showed signs of having genuine religion and qualifications of a deacon so he was ordained as a deacon and proved faithful to that office. He would go to see the sick members, report the same to the church and urge others to go; he would do all this, and yet he was found in all his church services.

He moved to McRaeville, Georgia in 1935 and united himself with The Mount Arrett Primitive Baptist Church where he served as Chairman of the Deacon Board and Superintendent of the Sunday School until his passing, June 20, 1975 at 7:30 p.m.

He was united in Holy Matrimony to Mrs. Mamie Jackson, to this union seven children were born. Mrs. McBride and four children preceeded him in death.

He leaves to cherish his memories three children, Mrs. Gladys Herring of McRaeville, Georgia, Mrs. Marie Hampton of Bainbridge, Georgia, and Mr. J. T. McBride of Miami, Florida; 28 grandchildren, 47 great grandchildren, 11 great, great grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
