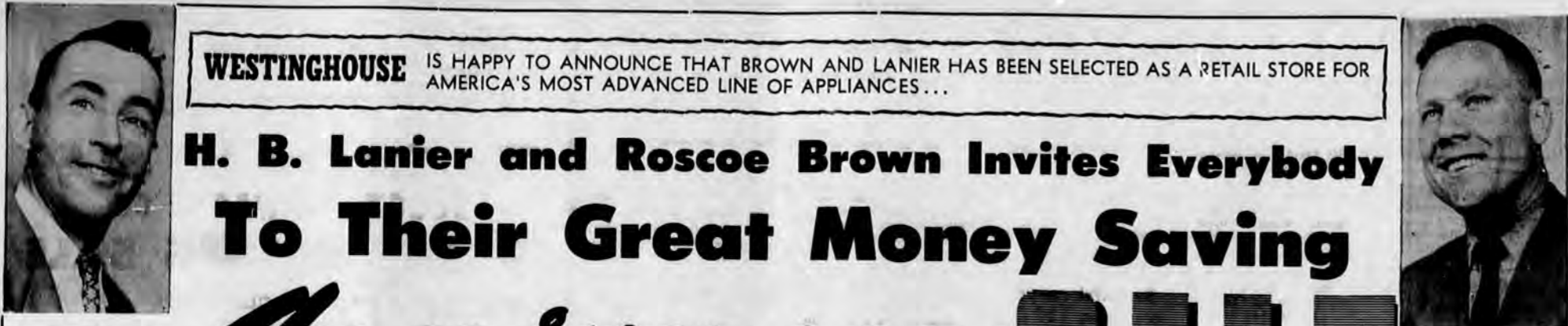

**Treat soil in fight with plum curculio**

Will spray corn producers many times at harvest.

**GAHI 1 FOR GEORGIA**

Perhaps you plan to grow some millet this summer. If you do, the hybrid Gahi 1 Millet may be the variety you will want to plant. It has produced nearly three times as much forage after August 1 as common millet, and it is much leafier. Compared with Starr millet, it is equal in quality and superior in production.

Gahi 1 starts off faster from seed than Starr millet, recovers when grazed or mowed and yields considerably more forage per acre per year.

Gahi 1 is best used to supplement permanent pastures. Staggered plantings of this millet should be made, beginning in July. It should be seeded on a well prepared seedbed which has been fertilized and limed according to soil test. This seed, however, should not come in close contact with fertilizer.

Gahi 1 should be grazed down to 36-inch rows at the rate of eight to 12 pounds of seed per acre. This should be top dressed with 60 to 100 pounds of actual nitrogen per acre in split applications.

Gahi 1 should be grazed down dressed with 60 to 100 pounds of actual nitrogen per acre in split applications.

You should allow the plants to accumulate 18 to 20 inches of growth before additional grazing.

A succession of plantings with rotational grazing should be practiced. For more information about hybrid millet see your county agent.

**IN CASE OF FIRE**

What would you do if a fire should start on your farm? This is a question that every person living on a farm should be able to answer. The five most important steps to follow in case of fire are:

1. Get everyone out of and away from the building on fire.
2. Call for help from nearest telephone—or make sure someone goes for help.
3. Try to keep the fire from spreading. Protect other buildings, livestock and property.
4. Assist the fire department in getting water and moving equipment as directed.
5. Take steps to protect property against damage by weather or moisture after the fire is out.

Farm and home pressure systems are all useful in protecting farm families and property from fire. Plan ahead on how you would give specific directions on how to get to your farm should you need help.

**HYBRID SEED CORN**

Just a few years ago, it was hard to find a farmer in Georgia who planted hybrid seed corn. But today, according to a recent survey, more than 80 per cent of the state's farmers are planting hybrid seed corn.

A few farmers, however, still believe that it is all right to get their seed corn from the crib if they planted hybrid corn last year. This is not so.
