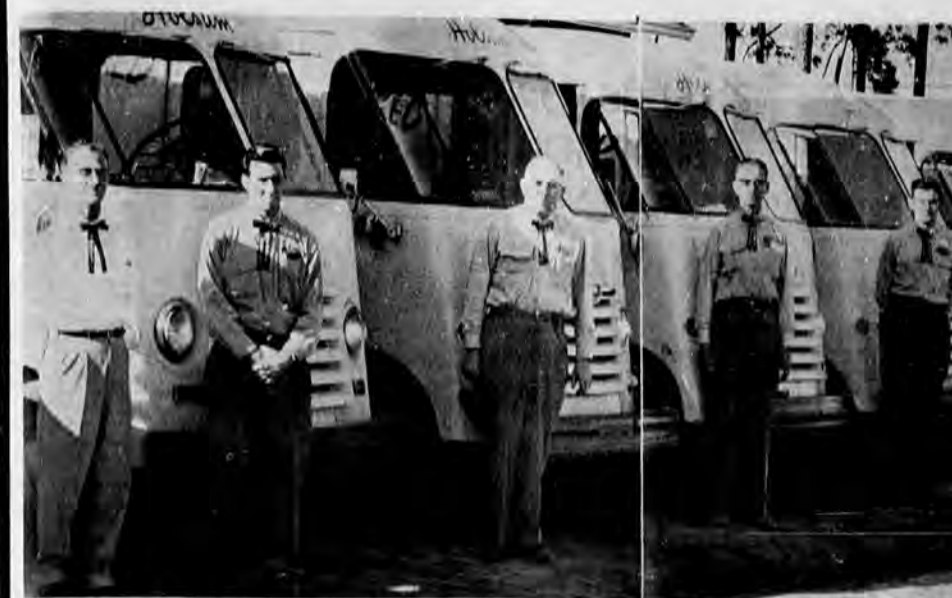

Harvesting wet cotton may result in over-drying, which lowers quality and means lower profits, says Richard Long, Extension cotton marketing specialist.
