City Businesses Set Hours for 1953

This week Josh Lanier, chairman of the Statesboro Merchants Committee, announced that business in Statesboro will observe the following holidays during 1953: Saturday, July 3, Independence Day; Monday, Sept. 7, Labor Day; Thursday, Nov. 26, Thanksgiving; Friday and Saturday, Dec. 25-26, Christmas; Friday, January 1, New Year.

Closing hours were set as follows: Automobile dealers will open at 7:30 a. m. and close at 6 p. m. They will remain closed on Wednesday afternoons throughout the entire year. Tractor dealers will open at 7 a. m. and close at 6 p. m. from March 1 through September 30. They will open at 8 a. m. and close at 6 p. m. from October 1, through February 28. They will remain open on Wednesday afternoons throughout the year except the first Wednesday of May and thereafter until the first Wednesday of Tobacco market.

Auto parts and supply dealers will open at 7:30 a. m. and close at 6 p. m. They will remain open on Wednesday afternoons throughout the year. The hardware stores will open at 7 a. m. and close at 6 p. m. except October and January when they will open at 7:30 a. m. and close at 8 a. m. The hardware stores included are Statesboro Buggy and Wagon Co., Hartley and Proctor, W. C. Atkins and Son, and Farmers Hardware Co.

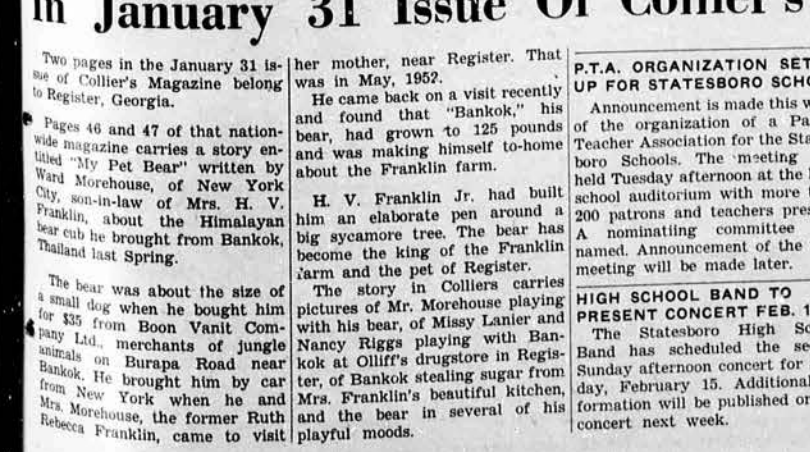
