Add to first mixture alternately with buttermilk. Mix in raisins and nuts. Turn into two 9-inch paper-lined cake pans. Bake in slow oven, 300 degrees, about 1 hour or until cake leaves sides of pan. Fill as follows then cover with some of the filling or with 7-minute icing.


