Georgia Farm Bureau Day was saved for Georgia farmers, cotton September 28. And no county in Georgia supports its Farm Bureau more enthusiastically and completely than Bulloch county. Year after year it leads the state in membership.

But even so there's always room for additional members.

Your Farm Bureau has blazed a trail of progress for Bulloch county and Georgia Farmers. These accomplishments did not come into being overnight. 


