COLUMBIA, S.C. – [Zykeria Williams](#) ran the 100 hurdles in 13.70 to break the Georgia Southern record en route to finishing third in the event, and the Eagle track and field squad posted six top-10 finishes at the Gamecock Invitational Saturday afternoon.

Williams' record-breaking time came in the preliminaries, and the sophomore posted a wind-aided time of 13.58 in the finals to finish third. She also took seventh in the 200-meter dash (24.12) and 10th in the long jump (5.41m).

[Abbey Arnett](#) placed ninth in the 800-meter run (2:23.07), and [Scovia Ayikoru](#) finished 10th in the 100-meter dash (11.89). [Martina Takang](#) took 10th in the discus (39.35) and recorded a personal best in the shot put (11.38m).
