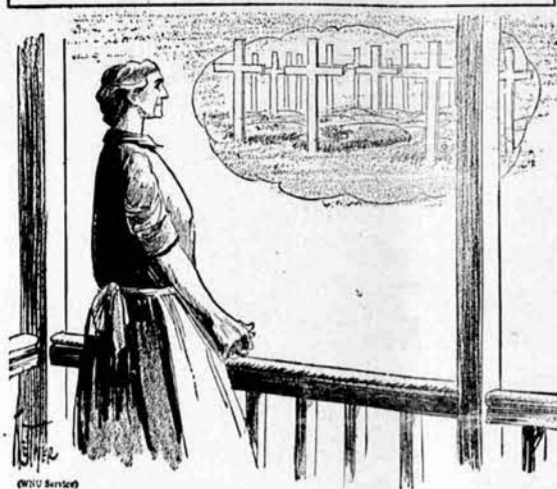

## FBI NEEDS HIGH SCHOOL GRADS TO FILL CLERICAL POSITIONS

The Federal Bureau of Investigation is urgently in need of young men and women who are high school graduates to fill clerical positions in Washington, D. C. In order to obtain one of these positions, applicants must be high school graduates, between the ages of eighteen and thirty-five years and must be of excellent moral character.

The FBI is also presently accepting applications for the position of Special Agent from men, age twenty-five to forty possessing a law degree or accounting degree with three years of actual accounting or auditing experience. Also, applicants possessing a college degree and otherwise qualified will be considered for the position of special Employment Agent, and those appointed will at the expiration of one year be considered for designation as regular Special Agents. The starting salary for all Special Agent positions is \$4149.60 per annum.
