Steven Fisk Named Sun Belt Men's Golfer of the Week

**STATESBORO** – Georgia Southern's [Steven Fisk](#) has been named the Sun Belt Conference Men's Golfer of the Week, the league announced today.

It's the seventh time in his career and the third time this season that he has earned the honor.

Fisk collected his fifth victory of the season when he earned medalist honors at the Schenkel Invitational March 17. It was the eighth victory of the senior's career, which ties Jodie Mudd (1979-82) for the school record. Fisk shot 70-67-65=202 (-14) to become the fourth Eagle to win the tournament and the first since Scott Wolfes in 2014.

His 65 Sunday helped the Eagles post a team score of 868, which tied the tournament record, equaling Alabama's total shot in the first round in 2012. The Eagles won the team title for just the second time in the 40 years of the Schenkel Invitational.

Georgia Southern returns to action when the Eagles compete at the Mason Rudolph Invitational, hosted by Vanderbilt, April 5-7, at the Vanderbilt Legends Course in Franklin, Tenn.
