The shrimp was wonderful. No

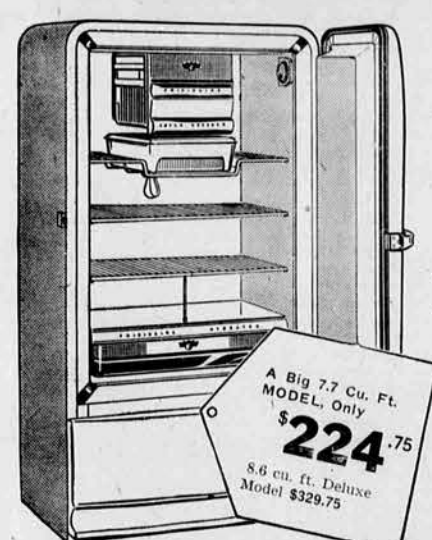
