STATESBORO – Georgia Southern volleyball coach [Chad Willis](#) announced today that Zach Harris has been promoted to graduate assistant and Sean Drexler has joined his coaching staff as a volunteer assistant.

Harris served as the team's volunteer assistant coach last season after serving as a manager in 2018.

"We've been fortunate to have Zach as a part of our program for the two years we've been here as a staff and we're thrilled to be sliding him into our graduate assistant role for 2021-2022," said Willis. "Zach has been instrumental in the day-to-day operations of our program - especially his hard work and efforts to drive and help create our creative media plan. We look forward to Zach's continued dedication and commitment as he completes his master's degree."

Drexler played four seasons of men's volleyball at the University of Charleston, where he recently graduated with a bachelor's degree in movement science. The libero played in 61 sets this season and posted 101 digs. A two-time selection to the EIVA All-Academic Team, Drexler finished his career with 237 digs in 180 sets.

"We've had the opportunity to interact and talk with him the past couple of weeks and are confident Sean will add great energy to our staff and team.
