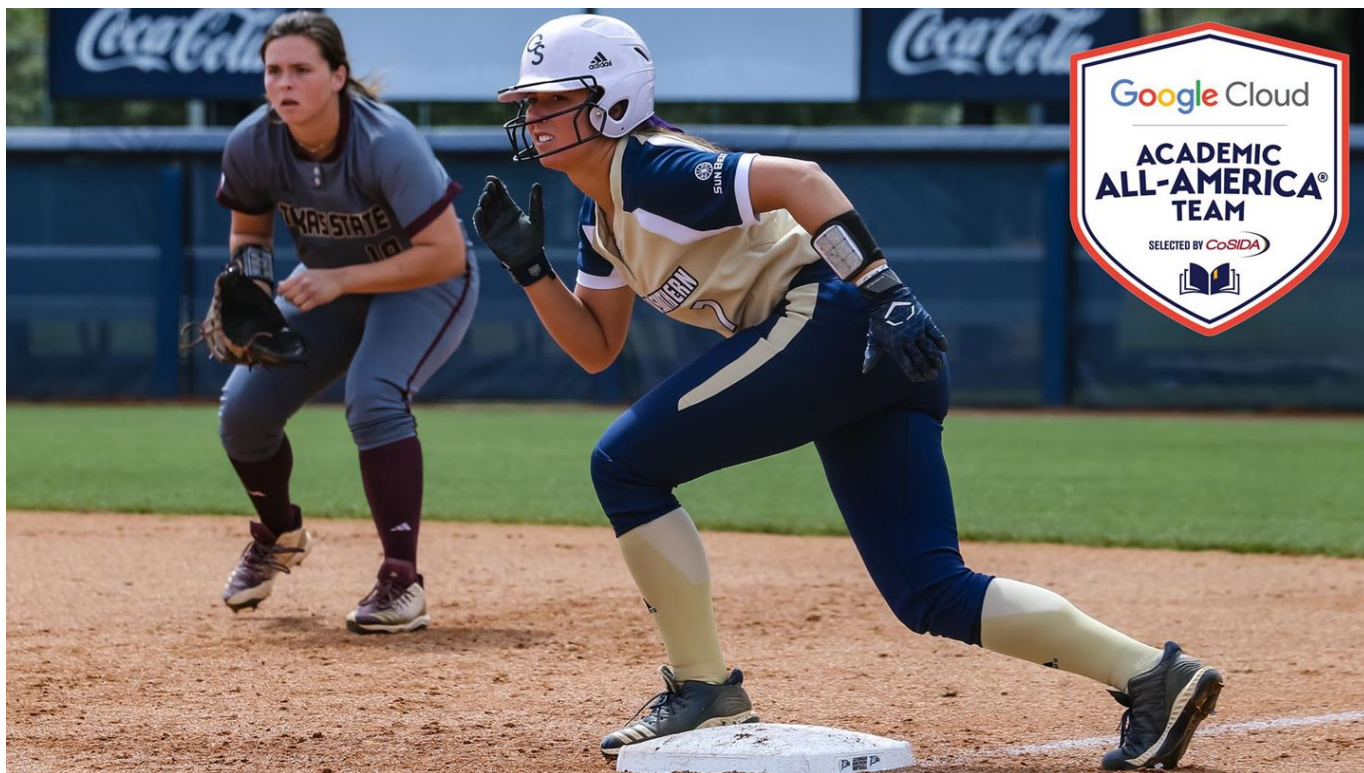

Shelby Wilson Named CoSIDA/Google Cloud First-Team Academic All-American
Becomes only the second Eagle to earn first-team Academic All-America softball honors

STATESBORO - Georgia Southern softball outfielder [Shelby Wilson](#) has been named a First-Team Academic All-American, announced today by CoSIDA and Google Cloud. Wilson becomes just the second player in Eagle softball history to earn first-team Academic All-American honors as awarded by the organizations.

Wilson enjoyed a career season for Georgia Southern in 2019 as the junior hit .354 with eight doubles, eight home runs and 37 RBI. She also drew a team-leading 30 walks for a .481 on-base percentage. Wilson ranked among the Sun Belt Conference's leaders in slugging percentage (8th, .600) and on-base percentage (4th, .481).

In the classroom, Wilson carried a perfect 4.0 GPA in exercise science, and graduated in May with her bachelor's degree, finishing her studies in only three seasons. She has received a teaching position in Effingham County at South Effingham High School and will be teaching science classes as well as becoming the new assistant for their softball team.
