The Eagles are 3-1 in Sun Belt home openers under coach [Mark Byington](#) and have won the last two. Byington is one win away from becoming the fifth coach to win 100 games at Georgia Southern. The Eagles are 6-3 against ULM since joining the Sun Belt. Five of those games have been decided by four points or less, and the Eagles have won three of them.
