MONROE, La. – Friday night at Fant-Ewing Coliseum, the Georgia Southern volleyball team was in action against UL-Monroe. The Warhawks (8-14, 1-8) would defeat the Eagles (8-15, 2-6) 3-1 for their second conference win of the season.

Camila Gomez led all Eagles with 13 kills on the evening, while [Lauren Reichard](#) led all Eagles with five blocks. The Blue and White started the evening winning the first set 25-13, before dropping the final three sets 25-22. In all three of the final sets the Eagles were able to bring the score back to level or take the lead.
