**STATESBORO, Ga.** - Due to expected cold temperatures Friday, the start time of Georgia Southern baseball's season opener against Bethune Cookman has been moved up to 4 p.m.

Temperatures are expected to be around 45 degrees at 4 p.m. on Friday with temperatures dropping below freezing overnight. All three days are predicted to have clear skies with Saturday's high sitting at 57 degrees.

The three-game weekend series continues on Saturday at 2 p.m. and Sunday at 1 p.m.

The Wildcats finished third at the Coral Gables Regional last year and return one of the top pitchers in the MEAC in Keith Zuniga.
