BA in Modern Languages**

Following review of the recommendation adopted by the Faculty Senate at the March 26, 2008, Faculty Senate meeting, as provided in your memo of April 2, 2008, I have approved the motion below presented to the Senate by Dr. Clara Krug.

MOTION:

To have the Senate remove from the table page 54 of the Librarian's Report of the Undergraduate Committee minutes of November 13, 2007. The section relating to Foreign Language programs was tabled at our February 14, 2008, meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.

B.A. in Spanish

JUSTIFICATION:

The department of Foreign Languages proposes the redesignation of three programs, two of which have very small enrollments, into one degree: B.A. in Modern Languages with concentrations in three different areas. The B.A. in Spanish will be redesignated as the B.A. in Modern Languages, with concentrations in French, German, or Spanish. The B.A. in French and the B.A. in German will be eliminated.
