All of the books are about the Bahai Faith, which is an emerging independent world religion that believes in the unity of all peoples and religions. The books are by written by various scholars and founders of the Bahai Faith and deal with a variety of topics such as the teachings, philosophy, or history of the Bahai Faith. Some of the books also deal with special issues such as the Bahai perspective on world peace, the equality of men and women, and the spiritual nature of humanity.
