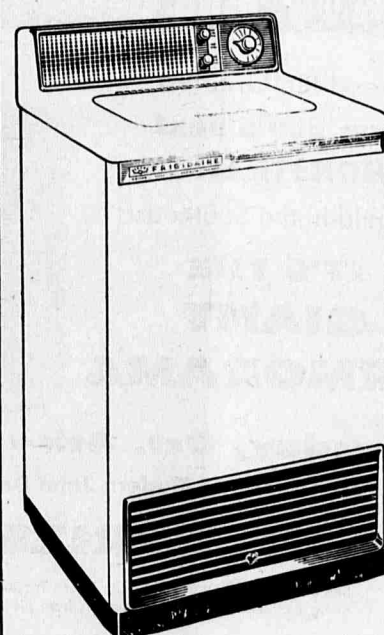

Heavy rains this summer have had varying effects on farms of the Ogeechee River Soil Conservation District cooperators in Bulloch. They have washed land that was once considered too flat to terrace. They have filled up many of our ponds, and they have helped to grow the best crop of weeds and grass in recent history. You would ordinarily expect me to dwell on the first effect—that of erosion—but today I would like to mention the last—weeds and grass—and discuss it briefly.

Over the county I have had occasion to walk over farms and try to get through weeds too tall to see over, bringing to mind a good example, Mr. Rufus G. Brannen of the Emitt community.

It was like trying to go through a ty-ty-bay on one occasion. Another example is that of Mr. H. C. Bazemore east of Statesboro on the Savannah highway. He has one of the best growth of beggar weeds following corn I have ever seen. Most farms have this same condition, or similar ones, this year, and I'm very pleased with it. Proper management of this very valuable organic matter will protect your soil from erosion, help it hold more water, and add fertility to it.

On several occasions I have had the pleasure of walking over such a field as mentioned above on Mr. Bazemore's farm after a rotary mower had been over it. A soft, velvety cushion lay over the soil which reminded me of walking down the aisle of a church with plush carpets. What am I driving at? Just this: Don't burn or destroy that God-given growth of weeds and grass that has taken over your fields. Use it to enrich your land for the future. On that level land I mentioned above, you won't have to terrace if you'll keep plowing back tons of organic materials. Your soil

Farm and Family Features

Farm Bureau Group health service seems assured for Esla, Register—maybe Nevils

Esla and Register Farm Bureau chapters are virtually assured group health service and Nevils looks favorable, based on reports given at these meetings last week.

Mrs. Harry E. Futch is enrolling the Esla members in the health service program offered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield and reported to her group Tuesday night that she was only six away from having 60 per cent of the chapter signed up, which would assure them group rates.

Mrs. Futch stated that she was sure of some transfers and thought she knew at least ten more families in the community that would enroll.

Mrs. Leon Holloway advised the Register chapter Thursday night that she had enrolled some thirty-two families and did not see any reason why they would not have more than 60

per cent by October 10, the deadline for accepting members this year in the Blue Cross and Blue Shield health service programs.

Walton Nesmith advised the Nevils group Wednesday night that he had just started taking applications in that community for the health service and was getting excellent cooperation. Nevils will be in with more than 60 per cent enrollment, he stated.

A. L. Crittendon, fieldman for Blue Cross and Blue Shield, met with the Nevils chapter and discussed the services offered by his organization for the first time to this group. Mr. Nesmith stated that this would clear up any questions for the people in the Nevils community and speed up his enrollment.

MR. CRITTENDON MEETS WITH WORKERS

Mr. Crittendon met with all those enrolling Farm Bureau members in the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Tuesday night at the county agent's office and procured a favorable report from most of them. Portal West, Side, Warnock, Sinkhole and Denmark all were virtually sure of the group rates. The other chapters were meeting with good success but just had not taken the necessary time to contact the Farm Bureau members.

Mr. Crittendon also met with Willow Hill Negro chapter Tuesday night and recommended that they take out services under Blue Cross now and next year and Blue Shield if they did not care to go for both services now. They would also set up their own group within their individual chapters.

ESLA, NEVILS ASKED TO HELP WITH GILT SHOW

W. E. Gear, John F. Spence, Ed L. Wynn, and Gordon Hendrix were visitors at Esla and asked that the group work with the Southeast Bulloch School in putting on a gilt show in October. J. H. Futch, Esla president, named Arnold Parrish chairman of a committee to work out details for the show and stated he would also help.

Mr. Hendrix asked Nevils to also come in the gilt show program and was assured by those present that he could count on them. R. L. Roberts and Ray Trammel were asked by Walton Nesmith, their president, to assist with show plans.

Dr. A. B. Daniel enumerated the advantages of Bulloch county cooperating with the Red Cross bloodmobile program at Register. The unit will be back in Bulloch county October 2 from 2 p. m. to 6 p. m. He urged the people to make certain this program was not lost because of the lack of interest. It is just about a must program. The hospital is not set up to handle such a program without spending a lot of money. Then, too, unused blood taken at the hospital would have to be discarded where as the Red Cross is equipped to process it and make other uses of usable parts.

O. E. Gay reported to the Register group that an electrification clinic would be held at Robert Cox's farm in the Nevils community from October 10 to 12, which includes a meeting on the night of October 10.

Miss Henrietta Hall, Farm Bureau Women's chairman for the county, has set the county queen and talent contest for October 12, 8 p. m., at the Marvin Pittman High School auditorium. Seven chapters have already named their entrants.

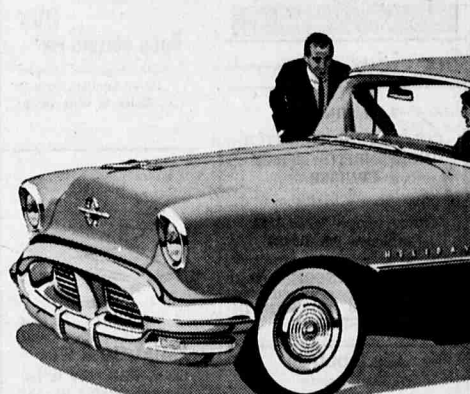
