

The scope of the Shooting Sports Education Center has not fundamentally changed since its inception. However, in the process of developing the project from concept to schematic drawings, preliminary pricing, and available funding the following decisions have been made:

1. The outdoor archery park has been designated as a Phase 2 project that requires \$562,000 to construct. Phase 2 will be developed once funding is secured.
2. Phase 1 consists of the indoor facility, its immediate surroundings, and support site work.
3. The indoor archery center has increased from the original scope by 3800 sq. ft. to more adequately support shooting events such as tournaments, workshops, and classes rather than just shooting training, instruction, and practice.
4. The indoor firing range increased by 630 sq. ft. to accommodate the 25 meter Olympic shooting distance (approximately a length of 9ft to each lane).

Response to RFI Question #3: Who is designing the structure and related facilities and when will the site and building plans be made available to the public?

The architect firm of Lyman, Davidson, Dooley, Inc. is the design firm and the construction management firm is AJAX Construction, Inc. The current plans that have been released in response to this RFI are at a schematic level and fundamentally what has been designated as the plan that will be used to move forward. The next step is for this plan to be developed into construction documents.

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
