Academics:

EOI scores improved in all of the seven subject areas.

Attendance has made steady strides from 2008 until present date.

- 2014 – 94.1%

Honor roll

Freshmen and sophomore honor roll showed a significant increase from 2008-2014

- 356 freshmen and sophomore students eligible for principals and superintendents honor roll in 2014.
- 331 freshmen and sophomore students eligible for principals and superintendents honor roll in 2011.
- 177 freshmen and sophomore students were eligible for principals and superintendents honor roll in 2008.

Behavior:

Incident Reports

- Out of School Suspension incidents of one or more days were reduced by 73.6% from 2008-09 through 2013-14:
 - 2013-2014 – 168
 - 2010-2011 - 267
 - 2008-2009 - 637
 - 2011-2012 – 181
 - 2009-2010 - 500
- Contact with Security from 2008-2009 to 2011-2012 decreased by 45%
 - 2011-2012 - 106 security interventions
 - 2009-2010 - 134 security interventions.
 - 2008-2009 - 193 security interventions.

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- Documented fighting conflicts from 2008-2009 to 2009-2010 has been cut in half with significant gains expected after this academic school year.
 - 2008-2009- 92 documented fighting referrals
 - 2009-2010- 45 documented fighting referrals
 - Each quarter since the first quarter in 2008 has shown significant decrease in referrals.

Climate:

Student and faculty involvement in the Advocacy Program has grown from 15 teachers in fall 2008 to all 105 teachers currently.

- 2008-09 – 15 teachers and 150 students
- 2009-10 – 80 teachers and administrators and 783 students
- 2010-14 – all 105 teachers and administrators and over 1,200 students

Students and teachers alike have grown from the advocacy program implemented in 2008.

- I appreciate my Advocate: 2009 – 99%; 2010 – 99.4%
- I look forward to weekly meetings: 2009 – 90%; 2010 – 97.7%
- My grades have improved with my Advocate's help: 2009 – 80%; 2010 – 85.7%
- My attendance has improved since joining an Advocate family: 2009 – 66%; 2010 – 71.5%

Student Safety Survey:

- Feel safe all of the time: 2009 – 24%; 2010 – 37%
- Feel safe most of the time: 2009 – 43%; 2010 – 42%
- Feel safe some of the time: 2009 – 25%; 2010 – 14%
- Never feel safe: 2009 – 8%; 2010 – 7%

Student involvement has increased from 56% to 80% in 2010.

- 2008- 894 students involved in clubs and organizations
- 2010- 1,277 students involved in clubs and organizations

2012 ACT scores: 2012 scores were the highest since 1995- In math and science MHS students scored much higher than the state average for students on the “college track”:

- Math – for students taking Al 1 & 2, Geometry, Trig, and a 4th other math the State average on the ACT is 21.6 – **MHS is 23.3**
- Science – for students taking Bio, Chemistry and Physics – State average is 23.3 – **MHS is 28**

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
