Article Length and Guidelines

Authors should consider the following general recommendations:

- *Because this journal is published electronically, page limits are not as relevant as they are in the world of print publications. This said, authors need to exercise some discretion with respect to length. (Appropriate length would be approximately between 15 to 20 pages.).*
- *Must adhere to MLA style rules.*
- *Need to follow our Guidelines for Submission, including the Final Manuscript Preparation Guidelines.*
